

## Hand-y Snowflake

Display your child's hands in a decorative snowflake to celebrate the winter season.

### Materials Needed:

- 6 sheets of white cardstock paper
- Glitter glue, glitter pens or metallic markers
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Stapler

### Time to Create!

**Step 1** – Trace both hands on a piece of cardstock paper. Repeat twice, for 3 sheets of traced hands.

**Step 2** – Place a blank piece of cardstock under each set of traced hands before cutting. You'll end up with 6 pairs of hands.

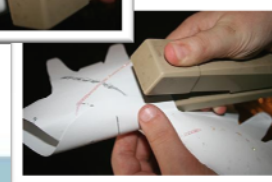
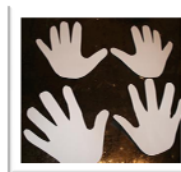
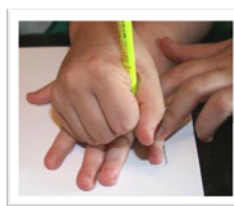
**Step 3** – Lay each pair of hands down with thumbs toward each other.

**Step 4** – Decorate hands as desired. If using glue, allow to dry completely.

**Step 5** – Put each pair back-to-back so the fingers line up. Be sure the decorated sides face out. Staple 2-3 fingers, but leave the bottom of the hands open.

**Step 6** – Take each pair and roll the bottom of each of the hands in toward each other so they overlap as shown. Staple together.

**Step 7** – Form a circle with the hands by stapling the thumbs and pinkies together (see photo at top).
