# **Hand-y School Supply Holders**

#### Materials Needed:

- Colored or patterned duct tape
- 8 X 11 foam sheets
- Permanent markers
- Empty, clean can (for Pencil Can)
- Magnet (for Locker Pocket)
- Low-temperature glue gun (for Locker Pocket)



# It's time to create your holders!

## **GLASSES CASE**

- **Step 1** Measure your glasses. Cut the foam sheet 2 inches longer than your glasses and 4 times longer than the width of your glasses.
- **Step 2** Fold the width in thirds. Use the duct tape to seal the side and one end of the foam.
- **Step 3** Decorate your case with duct tape and markers.





#### **SCHOOL TOOL HOLDER**

- **Step 1** Cut foam sheet to a desired size.
- **Step 2** Fold in half. Use duct tape to seal the side and one end of the foam.
- **Step 3** Decorate your holder with duct tape and markers.

# **Hand-y School Supply Holders**

### **PENCIL CAN**

- **Step 1** Cover the can with duct tape. Leave one inch above the can all the way around.
- **Step 2** Cut slits down the duct tape towards the can, 1/2 inch apart around.
- **Step 3** Tuck the tabs you just created in to the inside of the can
- **Step 4** Decorate with markers.





## **LOCKER POCKET**

- **Step 1** Cut foam sheet to be 2 inches less than the width of the locker.
- **Step 2** Fold sheet vertically leaving 1 inch extra on the back piece. Use duct tape to seal the sides.
- **Step 3** Decorate your case using additional duct tape and markers.
- **Step 4** Using glue gun, glue the magnets to the back side of pocket.
