Butterfly and Dragonfly Hand-y Craft

Materials Needed:

- foam craft sheets or construction paper
- craft sticks
- google eyes
- pipe cleaners
- glitter glue
- crayons or markers
- craft jewels
- scissors




Time to Create!

Step 1: Trace your hands to create the wings. For a butterfly, trace your hands with the thumb and fingers all together (as shown in the first picture to the right). For the dragonfly, trace your hands with the thumb, pointer and middle fingers together and your ring and pinky fingers together (as shown in the second picture to the right).



Step 2: Cut out the wings.



Step 3: Glue one wing onto the craft stick.

Step 4: Glue the second wing onto the craft stick overlapping the first wing slightly.

Step 5: Take the pipe cleaner and fold it in half. Twist the two ends together starting at the fold to about half way up to create the body. Then curl each side of the pipe cleaner towards the outside to create the antennas.



Step 6: Glue the body piece to the wings, directly over the craft stick.

Step 7: Glue the eyes to the top of the body, just before the pipe cleaner splits to become the antennas.



Step 8: Decorate the wings with crayons, markers, glitter glue and craft jewels.
