Materials Needed:

4 copies of flowers (see template) Crayons Scissors

To prepare for this activity, photocopy, color and cut out the flowers provided and label them with the words above (one per flower). Spread all the flowers, word side down, on the floor. Then have the children skip around the room singing the following to the tune of "Skip to My Lou":

Dropped my FLOWER, What'll I do? Dropped my FLOWER, What'll I do? Dropped my FLOWER, What'll I do? Look 'round the garden, darling

On the word "darling", the children pick up the nearest flower and hold it until called upon to read and sign the word. When all children have said and signed their word, replace the flowers and start again.
