

Hand-y Craft Valentines Flowers



Valentines Day is a time for us to express our feelings for each other. We exchange cards, flowers and chocolates. This year, why not combine a couple of these Valentine favorites by creating your own Valentine flower bouquet!

Materials Needed:

- Hershey's Kisses
- Red or Pink Construction Paper
- Red or Pink Transparent Gift Wrap
- Floral Tape
- Wooden Screws
- Artificial Plant Leaves
- Pencil
- Scissors



Time to Create:

Step 1: Trace both hands on to construction paper.

(You will need a set of two for each flower you are making.)

Step 2: Cut out hands.

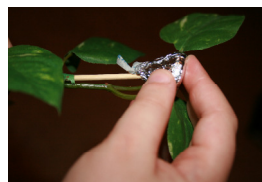
Step 3: Cut transparent gift-wrap into 3 ½ x 3 ½ inch squares.

Step 4: Fold the palm of the hands towards the fingertips.



Step 5: Take one screw and one stem of leaves and use the floral tape to tape them together up to the last inch of the screw.

Step 6: Push one Hershey kiss onto the screw with the point towards the screw.



Step 7: Stack a second Hershey kiss on top of the first kiss with tip pointing away from the screw.

Step 8: Place the tip of the Hershey kiss in the center of the transparent gift wrap pulling the edges over and around the kisses and screw.

Step 9: Starting at the bottom of the kisses, wrap floral tape around the transparent gift-wrap, screw and stem to secure them together.

Step 10: Tightly wrap hands around the kiss folded palm inward.



Step 11: Starting at ¼ inch up the hands, wrap floral tape around downward to secure them to the stem.

Step 12: Use the pencil to curl the fingertips down towards the stem.

Step 13: Place in a vase.

To make buds skip steps 10 & 11
