

Hand-y Craft **Firework Center Piece**

Summertime is a fun time to celebrate with family and friends. Help your kids create their very own centerpiece. Change the color palette to suit any occasion!

Materials Needed:

- 1 empty toilet paper roll
- 1 empty paper towel roll
 - 1-2 sheets red construction paper (depending on size of child's hand)
- 1-2 sheets blue construction paper (depending on size of child's hand)
- 1-2 sheets white construction paper (depending on size of child's hand)
- 1 sheet red tissue paper
- 1 sheet blue tissue paper
- 1 sheet white tissue paper
- 12-16 inches ribbon
- Ruler
- Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Star Stickers



Step 1: Cut the paper towel roll into two pieces 1/3 of the way down. You should have one piece that is 1/3 and one that is 2/3 of the original size, plus the empty toilet paper roll.

Step 2: Trace one right hand and one left hand onto each of the colors of construction paper and cut out.

Step 3: Using the ruler, measure the height of one of the rolls.

Step 4: Take a piece of constructions paper and mark the measurements for a rectangle with a width of 6-inches and a height based on the measurement of the height of the first roll (See Step 3). Cut out the rectangle.

- Step 5: Repeat step 4 with the other two rolls and sheets of construction paper.
- Step 6: Glue one set of hands to the top (6-inch side) of each of the rectangles.

Step 7: Glue each of the assembled rectangles onto the roll of the corresponding height (with the hands on the inside.)

Step 8: Using the pencil roll the finger tips outward.

Step 9: Place one sheet of tissue paper in the center of each roll.

Step 10: Tie all three rolls together with the ribbon.

Step 11: Place stickers on the outside of each roll.
