

Turkey Hand-y Craft

Help your children use their two little hands to create this sweet little turkey!

Materials needed for each turkey:

- 3 oblong vanilla cookies
- 1 round vanilla cookie
- 6 pieces candy corn
- 2 Nerds candies
- 1 miniature marshmallow
- 2-3 ounces of white chocolate



Step 1: Cut marshmallow in half.

Step 2: Place 1 Nerd in the middle of each of the marshmallow halves to create the eyes.

Step 3: Put the white chocolate in a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave chocolate at half-power for 1-2 minutes. Stir. Microwave for another 30 seconds until smooth.

Step 4: Dip the back side of the marshmallow eyes in to the white chocolate and place on them side-by-side at the top of one of the oblong cookies.

Step 5: Dip the large end of one piece of candy corn into white chocolate. Place it just below the marshmallow eyes to create the beak.

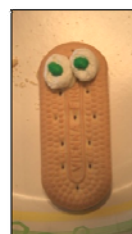
Step 6: Open the round cookie.

Step 7: Dip the small end of the remaining candy corn pieces in the white chocolate and place on the frosted side of the round cookie to create the feathers.

Step 8: Spread a thin coat of white chocolate on the icing side of the round cookie. "Glue" the round cookie back together.

Step 9: Spread a thin coat of white chocolate on the back of the oblong cookie. Then glue the oblong cookie on to the round cookie to finish your turkey.

Step 10: Take the remaining oblong cookie and cut it in half for your base. Set it on a plate. Spread a thin coat of white chocolate on the top of the base. Set your turkey down on it. Enjoy!
