Hand-y Craft Sucker Holders

Enjoy creating a fun sucker holder for Halloween.

You can create a bat, a ghost - or both!

Materials Needed:

- Black or white felt
- Googly eyes
- Rubber cement
- Scissors
- Pencil or marker





Time to Create a Bat!



- Step 1 Place both hands down on the black felt. Put your thumbs together so they are pointing up, touching from top to bottom to form the head. Spread your fingers out to the right and left to form the wings. Have a parent, teacher or friend trace your hands.
- **Step 2** Cut out the traced hands. Both hands form one bat, so don't cut between the hands.
- **Step 3** Fold the bat in half. At the center of the bat's body, cut two small slits ¼ inch apart from each other.
- Step 4 Glue eyes on bat's head (top of thumbs).
- **Step 5** Insert the sucker into slits.



Time to Create a Ghost!



- **Step 1** Place one hand down on the white felt. Have a parent, teacher or friend trace your hand.
- **Step 2** Cut out the traced hand.
- **Step 3** Fold the ghost in half. At the center of the ghost's body, cut two small slits ¼ inch apart from each other.
- **Step 4** Turn hand upside down. Glue eyes on top and let dry.
- **Step 5** Insert the sucker into slits.
