

Hand-y Craft Witch Hat

Materials Needed:

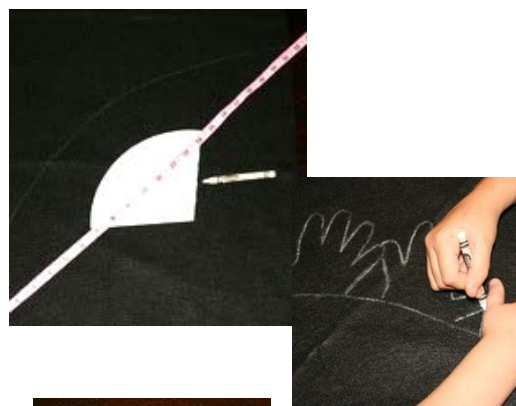
- Large sheet of black felt (36" x 36")
- White crayon for tracing
- Measuring tape
- Fabric glue
- Scissors



Time to Create a Hat!

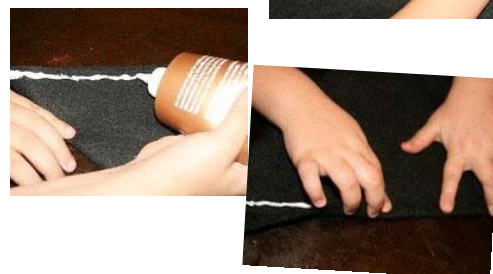
Step 1 – Print and cut out the hat template found on the next page. Lay the template on the felt, as shown.

Step 2 – Starting at the temple, measure your child's head with the tape measure. Mark the end of the measurement with your right thumb. Starting in the bottom left corner of the felt, lay the tape measure diagonally across it so your right thumb lines up with the right edge of the felt. Using the template as a guide, draw a semi-circle from one end of the tape measure to the other.



Step 3 – Trace your hands around the semi circle to create the brim. Carefully cut out the fingertips.

Step 4 – Gently rub the white crayon off of the felt. Then fold the hat in half leaving 1/8 - 1/4 inch long on the edge of the bottom layer.



Step 5 – Glue along one of the top straight edges of the felt. Stop gluing once you get the end of the straight edge. You don't want to glue your traced hands. Starting at the point of the hat, carefully fold the bottom layer over the glue. Let glue dry completely.

Step 6 – To wear, place hat on head and fold the traced hands slightly to create the brim. To use as a decoration, simply lay the hat on a flat surface and spread the hands out to create the brim.
