

Earth Day Hand-y Craft

The first Earth Day celebrated in the USA was on April 22, 1970. It is a day designed to inspire awareness and appreciation for the earth's environment. Many countries celebrate Earth Day every year.



Materials Needed:

- 1 piece of blue construction paper
- 1 piece of tan construction paper
- Green craft paint
- White craft paint
- Sponge
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue stick

Time to Create!

Step 1: Use a bowl or plate to trace a circle on to the blue construction paper. Then cut it out.



Step 2: To create the earth, use the sponge to create the continents on the blue circle. Allow paint to dry while doing step 3.

Step 3: Trace one of each hand on to the tan construction paper and carefully cut them out.



Step 4: On each side of your earth, glue each hand at the palm edge, with thumbs towards the top.

Step 5: Use the other end of the sponge to create clouds covering the Earth.



Step 6: Complete your project by selecting a phrase from below or creating your own to put across the Earth. You can print it, cut it out and glue it or you can use a marker to write one directly on the Earth when it has dried completely.
