

July Hand-y Craft: Chore Wheel or Activity Spinner

Make chore time fun with a chore wheel, or create an activity wheel to help you decide what to do when you are bored. Give the spinner a whirl and let it decide what activity or chore to do next!

Materials Needed:

- 2 Sheets of cardstock
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Glue
- Paper brad
- Pushpin
- Pictures and/or markers
- 8-inch plate to trace
- Scissors



Time to create!

Step 1:

To create the wheel, trace the plate on a piece of cardstock and cut it out.



Step 2: On the second piece of cardstock, trace one hand and cut it out.

Step 3: Put glue on the tip of the thumb, middle, ring, and pinky fingers. Fold them towards the palm and press down. Leave the pointer finger extended for the spinner.

Step 4: Using the ruler, draw 2 -5 lines across the wheel to divide it into sections.



Step 5: Write, draw, or glue a clip art image for your chores or activities in each section of the wheel.

Step 6: Have an adult use a pushpin to punch a hole through the center of the wheel and the spinner.



Step 7: Put the paper brad through the holes to connect the spinner to the wheel. Fasten the brad (but not too tightly!)



Step 8: Bend the index finger on the spinner up slightly to help the spinner spin smoothly.

Step 9: Spin to select your first activity. Have fun!
