# A Tasty WOrd Sclambe

## Activity & Worksheet

#### **Objectives...**

- Manipulating letters to spell words.
- Spelling skill development.
- Matching a word to its appropriate sign.
- Practicing ASL.

### Materials Needed...

- Teacher's Vocabulary Guide (TVG), 3a: Food.
- Student Vocabulary Worksheet (SVW), 3a: Food.
- (1-3) boxes of fruitflavored Jell-O.
- A paper plate (for each student).
- "Word Scramble" worksheet (for each student).

See National Standards for Volume 3



This lesson is a good activity for building spelling skills. Students will unscramble the letters to make one of their vocabulary words from Volume 3 while practicing American Sign Language (ASL).

## presentation

Prior to distributing the "Word Scramble" worksheet, have students complete their SVW for Volume 3. You will also need the TVG.

**Guided Practice**... The following review activities can be done before doing the worksheet activity.

- Jell-O Writing: Students, using their SVW they completed, can spell each of the "Food" vocabulary words in their Jell-O and then sign it—it's a tasty activity! Pour just enough Jell-O powder to cover the bottom of each student's plate.
  - **Peer Review:** Once students have reviewed the spelling of each word, they can quiz each other. Have students partner up.

**Example**... Student 1 will sign "banana." Student 2, using their Jell-O or a piece of paper, will then write the spelling of that word. When Student 1 has signed all of the vocabulary, they switch roles and Student 2 signs the words for Student 1. **Note:** If the students have already completed volume 5, they can fingerspell their words—a great tactile skill for learning.

• **Worksheet:** If students are ready for a fun challenge, hand out the word scramble activity.

**Independent Practice**... When all students have completed the activity worksheet, have students partner up and check one another's work. When students are done reviewing each other's worksheets, the teacher can review the answers with the class.
